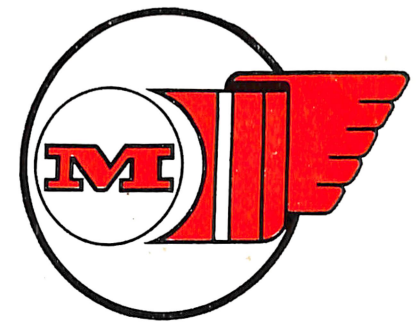

S. Marshall & Sons Limited, are situated at Southowram, Halifax where our two large works, Brookfoot Works, and West Lane Works, produce high quality Pressed Concrete Products—namely Concrete Flags, Kerbs, Channels and Edgings.

We are one of the largest producers of Pressed Concrete Products in the British Isles.

Marshalls (Teesside) Limited, formerly Stockton Stone Limited a comparatively new-comer to the Group, is now re-organised and re-equipped with the most up to date Hydraulic Presses in the Country, and again are producing Hydraulically Pressed Concrete Flags, Kerbs, Channels and Edgings.

They are ideally situated to supply the North of England and Scotland.

The quarrying of stone is one of the most ancient industries in existence but we at Southowram, Halifax, commenced operations in 1880 (S. Marshall & Sons Ltd.).

Today we still produce large supplies of sawn York Stone Flags, Garden Walling, Crazy Paving etc. from the Elland Edge Bed of Flagrock, and these are supplied throughout the length and breadth of the country.

Halifax Tool Co. Limited, with works at Southowram and Heckmondwike, produce the Halco range of rock drilling machines and equipment, also the Halco Reliance range of diesel engined and electrical industrial tractors.

Power Handling Sales Limited at Bingley, Yorkshire, are the marketing and servicing organisation for Halco and Halco Reliance products in the North of England, Northern Ireland and Eire.

Fielden Engineers Limited, are specialist engineers at Sowerby Bridge, Halifax, who manufacture Hydraulic Rams and Control Valves.

Halifax Tool Co. (South Africa) (Pty.) Ltd. in Johannesburg, deal with the marketing and servicing of Halco products in South Africa.

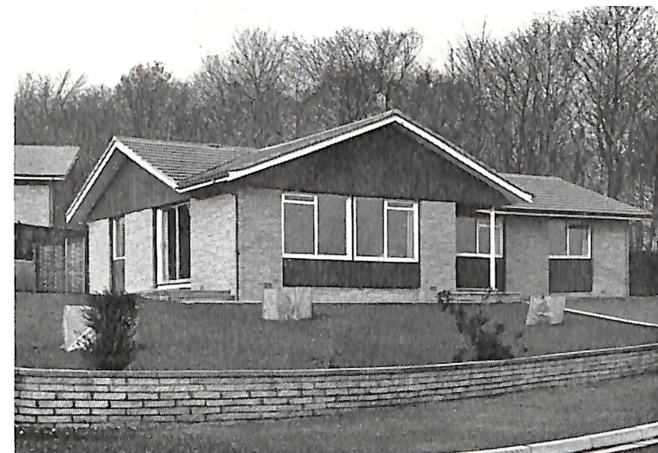

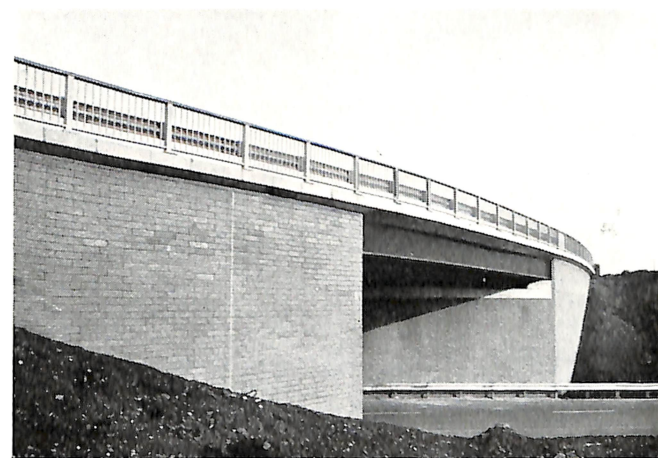

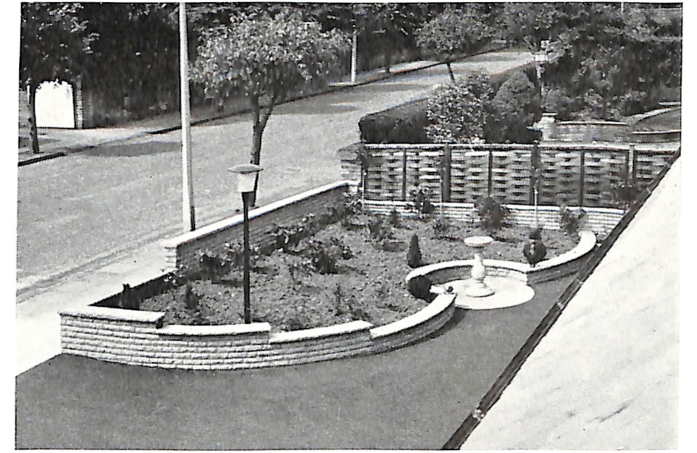
"All the charm of Natural Stone" a sales slogan typified in this attractive bungalow clad in Tudor Stone. The boundary walls are of Marshalite.

Strength and an attractive finish two requirements of a facing for a motorway bridge. Tudor Stone satisfied these requirements and alleviates the monotony of motorway travel.



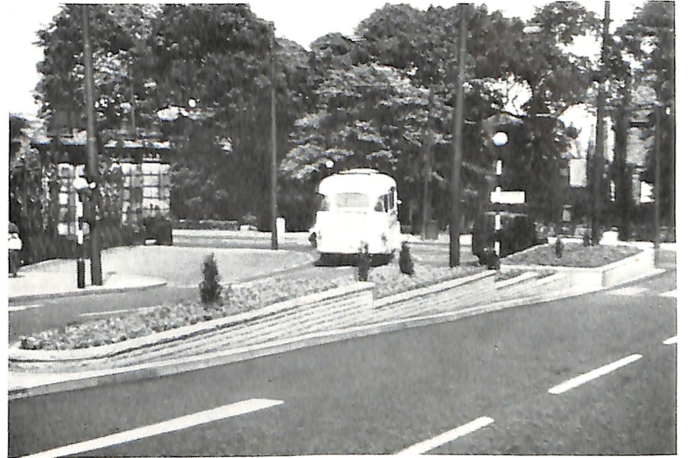

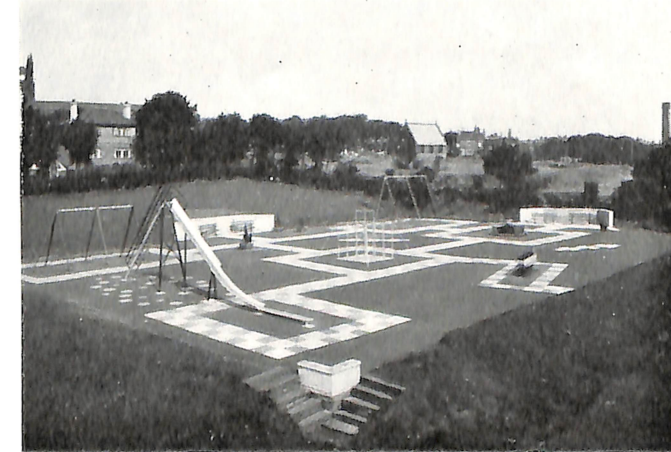
A quiet corner of a private or public garden can be neatly beautified by the use of Marshalite Walling.

FLAGS and KERBS from Recreation Areas to Private Street Works



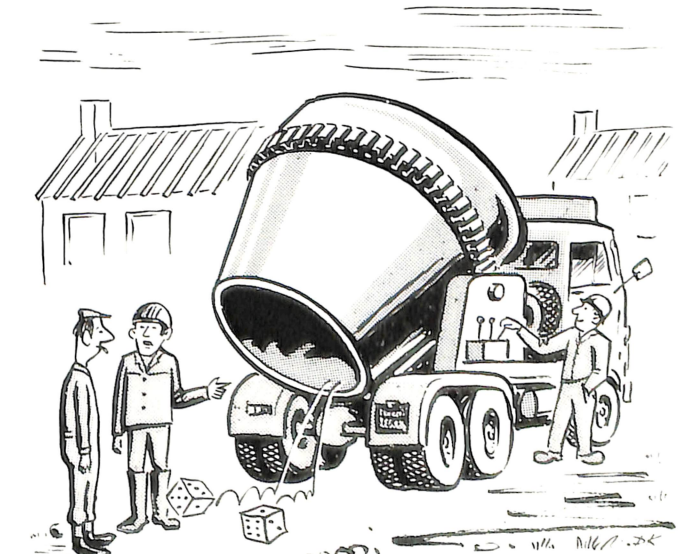
