Installation	Patio & pathways for domestic pedestrian use only Not suitable for use around a swimming pool, hot tub or on balconies Can be applied in wet or dry weather conditions but water must always be added Always install ample falls to take surface water to a drain or soakaway and always install on a free-draining sub-grade Drainage holes should be used when paving is laid on a full mortar bed. Pour Jointing Compound onto saturated paving. Brush into joints & sweep up excess material. Keep saturating area with water to activate. Ensure residue is washed away to avoid surface staining. Leave to dry
