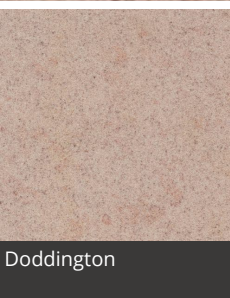


## Doddington Masonry & Facades
