# Northern Highways Depot, Sandy, Bedfordshire

## Challenge

At around 7000m2 this hard standing area for mixed vehicle types needed to be robust in its structural nature but also be delivered to programme and cost constraints which made contractor tendering a challenge.

### **Solution**

- Working with a strategic contractor partner a full evaluation of the project was undertaken to identify if an alternative design solution could deliver savings in build programme and costs
- The design would also consider a sustainable drainage solution based on the use of permeable concrete block paving
- All design work would be fully supported with indemnified design warranties

#### **Outcome**

- Removal of a 125mm thick DBM layer from the original design specification
- Reduction in structural build up, programme length, construction traffic and carbon impact
- Support of a successful tender bid delivering lower upfront costs and overall project savings
